Digital health: Exprivia technology for more efficient home care in the BAT area

The eLifeCare platform was recently presented at the Fiera del Levante trade fair: the platform helps the Barletta-Andria-Terni (BAT) Local Health Authority control integrated home care managed by the cooperative Auxilium and is aimed at improving patient service and reducing healthcare system costs.

14 September 2018. The digitalisation of the local healthcare system also involves the management of Integrated Home Care (IHC) through smartphones, tablets and advanced telemonitoring devices: the **cooperative Auxilium** manages IHC on behalf of the BAT Local Health Authority and has adopted the **Exprivia** eLifeCare's technological platform to manage the information flows related to the health services that it provides daily in the homes of over 600 people in the Barletta-Andria-Trani province.

Exprivia presented the project today during the "Mediterranean Health Forum" held at the Fiera del Levante in Bari; the platform will let Auxilium orchestrate everything relating to home care through a single IT tool, as well as manage the health authority's response more efficiently, even in an area as large as BAT, which has about 300,000 inhabitants. The platform is available in the cloud, offering all operators involved access from any device via an internet connection; this makes it possible to consult data about the patient's care regimen and assistance at any time, with the complete traceability of each intervention and consequent integrated and transparent reporting.

Francesco Bellifemine, the Production Manager of the Healthcare Area of Exprivia SpA said, "The increase in life expectancy and assistance needs is already a challenge to our health care system today, also because it requires caring for all citizens within a difficult economic context. The eLifeCare platform makes it possible to orchestrate the entire assistance system, optimising operators' travel times and routes, as well as reducing the local health authority's costs thanks to the increased automation of planning processes and the elimination of paperwork. In fact, it is a real digital revolution of the care model, virtually extending the hospital into the patient's home. Moreover, thanks to the integration of advanced audio-video technologies, in the near future we will be able to monitor patients and make remote diagnoses, as well as set up remote interventions especially in emergencies, finally opening the way to telemedicine".





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In fact, eLifeCare is one of the few complete solutions capable of automatically and in realtime acquiring the values of vital parameters (e.g. blood pressure, heart rate, body temperature, blood glucose, etc.) by means of suitable measuring devices equipped with Bluetooth or NFC connectivity, letting doctors carry out remote monitoring and teleconsultations in a totally safe manner.

Moreover, this advanced technology makes it possible to manage the supply and delivery of drugs in an entirely dematerialised and safe manner. Lastly, eLifeCare has the advantage of integrating with Edotto, the Regional Health Information System, allowing operators to view information relating to Personal Data, Individual Health Records and Individualised Assistance Plans directly on their smartphone at the patient's home.
