

EXPRIVIA: AWARDED A CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF REGIONE PUGLIA FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF THE HEALTHCARE INFORMATION SYSTEM EDOTTO

April, 12 2017. Exprivia - a company listed on the STAR segment of Borsa Italiana [XPR.MI] announces that its subsidiary **Exprivia Healthcare IT S.r.l.**, operating in the Healthcare market, has definitively awarded the tender called by the open procedure on behalf of **Regione Puglia**, for the assignment of application development services, operational management, application technology support and maintenance of information systems named **Edotto** and Pharmaceutical Processing Recipes.

The activities planned in the contract will cover the whole set of the technological infrastructure of the local Health Authorities of the region via cloud computing and specifically the evolution of the application infrastructure named Edotto.

The Edotto system, developed by Exprivia Healthcare and operating since July 2012, will be located at a single regional datacenter, and will allow access to its application components by all operators of the Regional Health System.

The contract has been awarded to the group of companies led by Exprivia Healthcare for a total amount of **19.5 million Euro, of which 12.7 of the company's relevance**. The duration of the contract will be **36 months, renewable for a further 24**.

Thanks to Edotto system and its pervasiveness in all health facilities of the region, Puglia will have a capillary management and control of the activities performed by health facilities, according to the standards of the most virtuous regions in the choices for digital healthcare.

The evolution that leads to the new health information system Edotto is driven by the regulations in the context of the national and regional health bodies, which provide the gradual trend towards **de-hospitalization of patients** with health care at the patient's home, the **reorganization of the regional care network** oriented to put greater attention to governance aspects of continuity of care, the need for local health are better able to reorganize processes and operating models and governance being able to rely on the capacities of its information systems.
